UG and PG Admission 2016-17

Prof. T D Subbanna brought to notice the decline in number of admissions in BA KEP (KM) & JPE (EM) and asked to improve admissions in these disciplines. Then Principal clarified to Dr. Malleshi, regarding the approval from UGC for Tourism and Hospitality Management Courses and added that grants from UGC are yet to receive to start the program.

Mr. B Niranjana Murthy suggested to include approved Kannada Ph. D scholars list to the common list of students for the present academic year.

Results of Nov 2016 UG & Jan 2017 PG Examinations

Prof. T D Subbanna discussed the reason for decrease in result of BA and he asked what action has been taken to improve results in English. Principal explained that though special classes are conducted by the teachers but students are irregular for such classes and even the memo sent to the parents has not brought much change. Dr. S. Shankarappa added that generally BBA attendance will be less in spite of mentor's supervision and the constant meetings. Mr. B Niranjana Murthy suggested not allowing the irregular students with less than 75% attendance for final exams so that the students become serious in attending the classes. He insisted squad should take care that students should not miss the class and the teacher should take the confidence of students and make the students to attend classes regularly. He also suggested maintaining a register for entries on reasons when a particular teacher does not engage a class.

Introduction of CBCS for UG Programmes

The Academic Council members approved to introduce CBCS to UG Programmes keeping in view of Autonomous Review Committee visit to the College and the College has applied for University status under RUSA scheme. Prof. T D Subbanna suggested conducting a workshop on CBCS to UG teacher and restructuring the syllabus according to the CBCS scheme as followed by other Colleges and Universities having CBCS scheme. The syllabus has to be restructured according to the new scheme by the concerned BOS. He suggested to submit the report regarding the advantages of having CBCS for UG programmes to the management. Prof. D.S. Sadashivamurthy, Prof. S.B. Nagaraja Murthy and Prof. P M Mahadevaswamy suggested to have CBCS scheme later for BA students in view of less number of admissions. Prof. T D Subbanna replied it will be considered after thorough discussion.

Approval of Revised Syllabi

The modified syllabus of B.Voc, M.Voc and Advanced Diploma was approved by the members.

Progress Report

Prof. T D Subbanna asked to brief out the Science Exhibition event organised by the College. Dr. Vijayamanjunath Guru explained that the students from different Colleges of University of Mysore, Kuvempu University and Mangalore University participated in the event. Professors from University of Mysore selected 12 students from different Science categories and are awarded with prize.

Prof. T D Subanna enquired about the screening of Cultural Programmes of the College. Principal and Dr. M P Somashekhar explained that the cultural committee from both UG and PG will scrutinize the events for vulgarity. Prof. T D Subbanna suggested organising State/University/Intercollegiate Debate Competition for the students every year.

Mr. B Niranjana Murthy opined that the student placement is less, compared to JSS Women's College. He suggested to have some training program to the students from external agencies so that the placement will be improved and the soft skills of the students will be improved. He added that Spoken English classes can be arranged by the external agencies so that the results in English as well as the vocabulary of the students will be improved. Dr. S. Shankarappa also suggested to have intense training programs from the placement cell. Prof. T D Subbanna suggested that the training program should be open to all students.

Prof. T D Subbanna asked to motivate the UG teachers to submit the project proposals to funding agencies and also suggested mentioning in the list of Research articles' publication whether the research journal is national or international. Dr. Malleshi suggested giving some credits to the good research article in order to encourage the teachers for research. Prof. T D Subbanna and Mr. B Niranjana Murthy suggested to giving the list of guides and the research students in each department with date of enrolment in Notes to Agenda.

The members congratulated the College and the editor for being securing third place for 'Prathibha' College Magazine in University level competition.

UG & PG Academic Calendars 2017-18


