## Agenda 27.2

### Remedial classes for Non-CBCS students having shortage of attendance

The UG regulations 2010 approved by GB have been brought to the notice of members with respect to the attendance. In accordance to regulation 4, candidate who fails to earn 75% of attendance in a semester will not be allowed to appear for the end semester examination.

In the above context UG Semester Scheme students having shortage of attendance in their third and fourth semesters of 2017-18 were not allowed to appear for end-semester examinations. According to semester scheme regulations, these students have to get re-admitted to third and fourth semesters of 2018-19. These re-admissions are not possible because of introduction of CBCS from the academic year 2017-18. In view of this, it is proposed to conduct remedial classes for these students to make good-off shortage of attendance to enable them to continue their education in fifth semester of 2018-19 and to take left-over examinations whenever they are offered. The same arrangement will be required for such students of fifth and sixth semesters of 2018-19.

The point has been raised and put before the council members for approval. In reply to this Prof. G. Kotreshwar suggested for preparing a timetable and scheme of teaching for those students having not permitted by the college to take up the examination due to shortage of attendance. Besides Dr. M.V. Shankar suggested to get undertaking from each of those students such that they must attend the remedial classes conducted in the college during the planned tenure without fail. Prof. S. Indumathi advised to cover the entire syllabus of the concerned semester within a stipulated period of time.

Prof. T.K. Umesh added his opinion positively for the same.

**Decision: All suggestions have been noted and the proposal has been approved by the council.**


**Providing Elective Course related to "Swachcha Bharath Abhiyan Activities" as Summer Internship – 15 days (100 hrs) under CBCS System**

Prof. B.V. Sambashivaiah explained the background and theme of the Summer Internship programme to the members. The proposal to offer the programme as elective under CBCS from the forthcoming summer was placed before the council for approval
