If a candidate is eligible for more than one course, the course which has highest marks in C3 will be considered. Prof. D.S. Sadashivamurthy requested the council to implement 3 DSCs (including one discipline in place of English, Hindi/MIL) for BA Programme different from the standard pattern. He gave the reference of UoM and other autonomous college which have framed and implemented the same pattern for BA Programme. Prof. B.V. Sambashivaiah conveyed that the current CBCS curriculum of the college is designed as per current UGC regulations. Further he highlighted the Clause of UGC Guidelines for CBCS that all papers except core papers offer complete freedom to the Universities in designing and reviewing the syllabi and enable them to offer their own distinct flavor with upto 30% flexibility while adopting the syllabus and maintaining of 70% equivalence in the syllabi. However, the chairperson of the council sought the opinion of the members to approve 3 DSCs for BA Programme in the college.


The Academic Council approved to implement 3 DSCs for BA Programme in the institute from the year 2019-20.
