10. ANY OTHER OBSERVATIONS:

1. The Committee found that the college has beneficiary utilized autonomous status granted to the college by introducing new PG/UG/Diploma Courses and by making innovative changes in contents of existing courses and other examination related reforms.
2. Academic Council/Finance Committee/ Government Council / Internal Audit committees have been formed and are working properly.
3. College has been re-accredited by NAAC with "A" grade in October 2008.
4. The college has introduced CBCS (Choice Based Credit System) on partial basis and the same may be upgraded to a full scale CBCS in the coming years.
5. The placement cell of the college has taken initiatives to conduct personality development classes. The scope & functioning of the cell may be enlarged by converting it into a Center for Innovation and Leadership (CIL)
6. Now that the college has started many PG courses, a senior faculty (from among PG teachers) may be designated as Coordinator for further strengthening the PG courses and research.
7. The college has started some self finance courses and the same may be restructured as regular courses with a provision of Scheme "A" (Merit Quota) and Scheme "B" (Payment Quota) admissions.
8. The college has been recognized as Nodal Center for recruitment by INFOSYS
9. The college has promoted the research activities which is evident as there are several minor and major research projects undertaken by its faculty from UGC.
10. The college is constructing a separate block for housing all the PG courses.
11. The college proposed to start M.Com. from the academic year 2010-11 and proposes to increase the intake for the following PG courses.
 - M.Sc. – Biotechnology 30 + 10 = 40
 - M.Sc. – Biochemistry 20 + 10 = 30
 - M.Sc. – Computer Science 30 + 10 = 40

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. Review committee recommends the continuation of Autonomy for JSS College of Arts, Commerce and Science, Ooty Road, Mysore for all the existing courses for the academic year 2009-10.
2. The committee recommends the following additional intake for the respective courses listed below.
 - a) M.Sc. – Biotechnology 30 + 10 = 40
 - b) M.Sc. – Biochemistry 20 + 10 = 30
 - c) M.Sc. – Computer Science 30 + 10 = 40
3. The committee recommends that the M.Com. course may be commenced from the academic year 2010-11 with an intake of 40 (Forty) subject to the condition that the Management takes steps to appoint at-least two qualified teachers (i.e., with Ph.D.) on regular basis to teach M.Com. course.
