Agenda 30.7 Overall results: April/May 2019 Examinations

The results of April/May 2019 Examinations have been displayed for the information of Council. Sri. M.V. Shankar, Prof. Morabada Mallikarjuna and Prof. T.K. Umesha raised and sought the clarifications for lowest results in II and IV Semester of BA and II Semester of BBA. Prof. Morabada Mallikarjuna asked the concerned members of the council to give reasons or justifications.

Prof. Morabada Mallikarjuna suggested to conduct remedial classes for the courses in which students are adjudged as slow learners. He also expressed his unhappiness over the results of II and IV Semester of BA and II Semester of BBA. He directed the teachers concerned to take necessary action to improve the results.

Sri M.V. Shankar advised to formulate some examination guidelines and reforms by incorporating the requirements which are very essential for the current education scenario and to meet the standards to evolve the college as a competing institute.

Points have also been raised for clarifications by Prof. Morabada Mallikarjuna and Sri M.V. Shankar on results of II Semester M. Sc Mathematics. Dr. N. Ravikumar, the faculty of Mathematics (PG), clarified that the introduction of a new course (paper) caused difficulty for students to get through the semester end examination.

In reply to queries on II and IV Semester of BA and II Semester of BBA, Prof. B.V Sambashivaiah said that required measures and remedial actions will be taken in future to improve the results.

Sri M.V. Shankar suggested presenting the results of students with grades of merit and classification as I, II and III Class in the final year.

Decision: Noted and Approved.



Agenda 31.3

Action taken Report

Sri M.V. Shankar raised a question on the ways of identifying the students as slow learners and about the number of such identified students who appeared for the remedial classes. It was brought to the notice of Sri Shankar that all those students whose performance is very poor in the regular activities and class assessments are categorised as slow learners. It was also brought to his notice the improved performance by slow learners after conducting remedial classes.

Agenda 31.4

Results of November-December 2019 UG and Decemeber 2019 PG

Examinations

Prof. Indumathi suggested to improve the results of BA and BBA by taking appropriate remedial measures. Sri M.V. Shankar wanted the results to be displayed course-wise for each programme and for which the COE provided the required details. The COE also threw light on to the council that the low pass percentage of I Semester of BA and BBA is due to the poor performance of students in English Language Course. COE also opined that the low


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percentage results of B.Voc in Software Development students' is mostly due to poor display of knowledge in skill component and the other course 'Constitution of India'. Dr. S. Shankarappa justified the poor performance of BBA students by stating that the students who have got admitted to the programme must have passed 10+2 or PU with very low grades in the supplementary examinations. Prof. G. Kotreshwar suggested to fill the gaps so that there will be improvements in results of such programmes. He also suggested to modify the admission policy. Dr. S. Shankarappa insisted the management to appoint separate teachers for the courses, namely, Constitution of India and Environmental Studies, so that the limitations of skills to teach those programmes with existing Political science and Geography teachers can be overcome. Sri B. Niranjana Murthy opined that the present system of teaching these courses will not create any problem and hence there is no reduction in the results. In addition to that, he also said that by continuing this practise there will not be any problem created on workload of present teachers.

It was also discussed in the council meeting that too much usage of mobile phones by students is also a root cause to poor results. Prof. Indumathi and others opined to check and to install the mobile phone jammers in the college premises.

Decision: Noted and Results have been Approved

The chairman sought the council to give authorization to nominate BOS members as Academic Council Nominees, as per the requirement for nominating the BOS members in Autonomous Colleges.

Agenda 31.6 Progress report

The council applauded the college for having obtained the CGPA of 3.21 with 'A' Grade from NAAC in the 4th Cycle of Assessment. Prof. T. K. Umesh suggested the college to emphasize on getting further up gradations

such as obtaining University status. Prof. B.V. Sambashivaiah expressed the efforts of the college to check, prepare and to execute the plan as per the possibilities.

In respect to the teachers' publications, Prof. G. Kotreshwar suggested to include columns and to mention the citation indexes and citation numbers. Sri M.V. Shankar asked the college about the existence of any rule to publish papers mandatory by teachers. Prof. B.V Sambashivaiah replied that teachers have to publish at least two articles in order to get recommended and sanctioned the annual increments.

Sri M.V. Shankar asked to clarify the number of visitors to library per day so as the available rich resources of text books can be made to serve the purpose. The latest statistics of 160 to 170 members' visit to the library has been given by the Librarian to Sri M.V. Shankar.

Dr. S. Prathiba brought to the notice of council members about some aspects which are left out in the curriculum of UG Botany courses and the absence of space to include the same in the syllabus in CBCS. In his reply to this, Prof. T. K. 
