Approval of Admissions 2020-21

Expert member of the Council, Prof. Malini sought the reasons for decreased admissions to PG Kannada and English Programmes. Chief Executive Prof. B. V. Sambashivaiah threw light on the admission criteria of the English department which demands a higher percentage of marks for admission than any other subjects and also mentioned that a plea has been submitted from the college to the Department of Studies in English, UOM to modify the above said criteria so that admissions can be improved. Prof. Morabada Mallikarjuna, the Director, also expressed his concern towards decreased admission to UG and PG programs in Arts and Humanities and insisted to take appropriate action towards improvement.

Prof. Malini, DOS in Zoology University of Mysore, appreciated the activities of PG departments and suggested PG departments to associate with reputed institutions/ research centers to promote research activities and take up more research projects.

Prof. Srinivas appreciated the activities of the teachers and suggested teachers to mobilise financial assistance from funding agencies to carry out research activities. He also suggested to motivate and recognize the teachers who have received financial assistance. Dr. Kumaraswamy, DOS in Commerce, University of Mysoreenquired about the contributions of faculty members of the Department of Commerce (UG and PG) and also suggested to recognize the achievements of teachers and motivate them.

Prof. B.V Sambashivaiah explained the initiatives of the college towards motivating teachers and expressed the readiness of the college to provide all the facilities to teachers to carry out research activities

Sri. B. Niranjanamurthy, Assistant Director, College Education Division, JSS Mahavidyapeetha suggested to understand the effectiveness of online classes.

Dr. Raveesha, Professor; JSSAHER, Mysuru, enquired about the technical aspects of ongoing online classes and suggested to organise an orientation programme for teachers on conducting online classes. Dr. Kumaraswamy mentioned the importance of teachers' preparedness as the online class will become mandatory in the figure.

Sri Shivanna, Joint Director, and District Skill Development officer suggested to incorporat skill component in each course to enhance employability. Further, he requested to organise a training programme for students concerning soft skills, problem-solving techniques, tips to face interviews, and behavioral aspects in organisations.

Prof. B.V. Sambashivaiah ensured the implementation of suggestions given in due course. Regarding online classes, he mentioned the involvement of faculty members in conducting online classes in the Covid 19 period and HODs documenting the same in Google sheet. Further, he assured that the college will organise an orientation programme for teachers on technical aspects of online teaching and also acknowledged the planning of the college to equip the entire campus with a Wi-Fi facility soon.

Concerning Skill Development initiatives, Prof B.V. Sambashivaiah furnished information about skill integrated programmes such as B.Voc, M Voc, and research activities under Kaushal Kendra, a status sanctioned by UGC and MHRD. Government of India. Further, he added that the college has been recognised as a training center under Kaushalya Karnataka Scheme to train students and youths for employment.

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Prof. B.V Sambashivaiah furnished information about the establishment of JSS RADIO, A Community Radio Station with financial assistance from JSS Mahavidyapeetha, which will be ready soon for the inauguration.

Prof. Morabada Mallikarjunaconcluded the meeting by appreciating the suggestions of the members and informing the faculty and Principal, to work towards the overall development of the college.

Approval of First year PG Admissions 2020-21

Prof. H Nagaraj sought the reasons for decreased admissions to PG Commerce Programme. Dr. H C Honnappa explained the reasons to the Council and requested Prof. M Kumaraswamy for clarifications.

Prof. M Kumaraswamy clarified that the number of applications received for admission to PG Commerce programme by the University of Mysore for this academic year were only 2400 instead of around 5000 applications every year. Further he clarified that majority of applicants this year have opted to take admissions to government colleges as the admission fee in government colleges is less compared to private and private aided colleges. Prof. M Kumaraswamy suggested the PG Department of Commerce to enhance academic activities, to organise coaching classes for NET/KSET and other competitive examinations availing the services of expert faculty in the UG department so as to attract students. He also enquired about the possibility of offering some concessions to students of the college willing to take admissions to PG programme in the same college. Prof. H Nagaraj and Dr. Raveesha endorsed the opinion of Prof. M Kumaraswamy and suggested giving publicity for the academic activities of the Department to attract local students.

Prof. Morabada Mallikarjuna and Sri. B Niranjanamurthy suggested the PG Depriment of Commerce and other PG Departments with decreased admissions to take appropriate measures to improve admissions in the coming year.

Agenda 33.5

Approval for submission of praposals for obtaining recognition for B.Voc in Digital Architecture and MCA

Prof. M Kumaraswamy enquired about the new programmes. Prof. B V Sambashivaiah explained the necessity and the demand for the introduction of the new programmes. He has clarified that the Curriculum (syllabus), structure of B.Voc in Digital Architecture programme has two components 40% of General Education Component (GEC) and 60 % of skill Development component (SDC). The teaching and evaluation of 40% of GEC comes under the purview of the college and the 60 % of SDC comes under the purview of NSDC. Prof. B V Sambashivaiah further clarified that the present physical infrastructure facilty available in the college is sufficient to run the programme and no additional infrastructure facility is required. Regarding the eligibility criteria he said that, the candidates with PU / +2 under skill stream are eligible for direct admission. For candidates with PU / +2 under regular stream, a six month level 4 training programme will be conducted for them to get eligibility for B.Voc.

Sri. B Niranjanamurthy explained the demand for admission to MCA programme. Prof. B V Sambashivaiah clarified that JSS Mahavidyapeetha and University of Mysore have already approved the the proposal for the introduction of the MCA programme and now the college has to take approval from AICTE.
