Approval of results of Odd Semester UG and PG programmes

Prof. M Kumaraswamy, Professor & Chairperson, DOS in Commerce, University of Mysore, University Nominee to the Acadmic Council, sought the reasons for 78% results in M. Sc in Physics and M. Sc in Chemistry. Dr. L Mallesha, HOD of PG Department of Chemistry and Dr. Vijaya Manjunathaguru, Coordinator of PG Department of Physics explained the reasons for 78% results to the Council. Dr. Srinivasa, Professor, DOS in Microbiology, University of Mysore opined that may be the students are not able to grasp the topics covered and lack of face to face interactions in the online classes conducted during lock down period might be the reason. Prof. Morabada Mallikarjuna, suggested the concerned department faculty members to give explanations through HOD of the departments to the issues raised and to take appropriate measures to improve the results.

Prof. Morabada Mallikarjuna drew the attention on the result of III Semester BBA. Sri. B Niranjanmurthy, Assistant Director, College Education Division JSS Mahavidyapeetha wanted to know the reasons for low results in some programmes. Mrs. Sreelalitha, Faculty member of UG Department of Commerce and Management tried to explain the actions taken to improve the results of BBA programme. Prof. Morabada Mallikarjuna suggested to give the explanations in writing. Prof. Morabada Mallikarjuna continued explaining the salient features of NEP – 2020 scheduled to implement from the academic year 2021-22 and

Approval for introducing Four Years UG Honours programmes from the academic year 2021-22

Dr. H. C. Honnappa putforth the agenda for the approval of Academic Council. Prof. M Kumaraswamy sought the clarifications regarding the Four Years UG Honours programmes to be introduced in the college. Dr. Prabuswamy clarfied that the college is planning to adopt the exsting B.Voc programmes schemes to some extent in the Four Years UG Honours programmes. Dr. H. C. Honnappa said that the college intends to adopt the schemes and procedures of University of Mysore for the Four Years UG Honours programmes with minor modifications under autonomous college regulations. The programmes are aligned according to NSQF levels. Prof. Morabada Mallikarjuna said this is the right time to concentrate, utilizing the opportunity to improve humanities departments, suggesting the faculties to work hard in this direction.

Dr. Malini Professor & Chairman, DOS in Zoology, University of Mysore, wanted to know about the combinations offered and the freedom for students to select the subjects and combinations of their choice. Dr. H. C. Honnappa clarified that three to four options are provided for students to select the subjects and combinations of their choice. Dr. Srinivasa, Prof. M Kumaraswamy and Sri Shankara Prasad, Excelsoft, Mysuru suggested to take opinions of the students. Dr. Malini further suggested the counseling of the students about the options and also the employment opportunities. Prof. Morabada Mallikarjuna suggested to educate the students with the options provided for studies in the Four Years UG Honours programmes. Sri. B Niranjanmurthy suggested that the Four Years UG Honours programmes should be helpful to students in career and job opportunities.

b. Approval of Scheme and Syllabus of M.C.A. Programme

Prof. B. V. Sambashivaiah informed the Council that the Scheme and Syllabus of Curriculum of M.C.A. Programme is in the A.I.C.T.E. pattern and college seeks the approval of Academic Council for the same.

c. Approval of Revised Syllabi of PG departments

Dr. H. C. Honnappa informed the Council that PG Department of English, Kannada, Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Biochemistry, Food Processing and Engineering have revised their syllabi from the academic year 2021-22 and requested the Council for the Approval

Dr. M. Y. Srinivas suggested that percentage of revision has to be mentioned. Dr. Raveesha, Professor, Faculty of Life Sciences, JSSAHER suggested that providing percentage is not sufficient but justification for the changes to be given for the revision and also opined that while adopting new syllabus up to 20% changes can be made. Dr. M. Kumaraswamy, DOS in Commerce, University of Mysore suggested to revise PG syllabi following the NEP 2020 syllabus. Prof. Mallikarjuna Morabada appended him. Finally Dr. H. C. Honnappa informed the concerned departments to provide the percentage details.

Agenda 35.7

Progress report

Dr. S. S. Malini wanted to know whether there are any incentives provided for teachers for Research Article publications and paper presentation. Dr. M. Y. Srinivas endorsed her opinion and Prof Kumaraswamy supported them. Principal informed the council that Research paper publications and paper presentation are considered for annual increment of PG faculty. Prof B. V. Sambashivaiah said that the PG faculties are getting UGC scale and the college shall recommends them for promotion to the next cadres as per norms.

Agenda 35.8

Approval of new syllabi of UG departments for the academic year 2021-22

Principal sought approval of Academic Council for the new syllabi of UG departments for the academic year 2021-22, under NEP-2020. Dr. M. Kumaraswamy suggested making required changes utitilising the provision under autonomous college while implementing NEP 2020 syllabus for UG programmes. Prof B. V. Sambashivaiah clarified that as per the notifications of University of Mysore, Affiliated Colleges and Autonomous Colleges of University of Mysore have to retain the syllabi of University of Mysore for the present academic year 2021-22.

Prof B. V. Sambashivaiah requested the Academic council to approve syllabi for NCC, NSS, Range & Rover, and Scout & Guide courses designed by the college as it is not available from Military

through UoM. In addition Prof B. V. Sambashivaiah requested the council to give approval for the college to register for ABC for the benefit of mobility of students from one college to another and he said that according to gazette notification, as an autonomous college it eligible for ABC registration.

Any other with the permission of the chair

Prof Morabada Mallikarjuna opined that there are certain delicate issues to be discussed and resolved before the implementation of NEP syllabus. He wanted to know whether all the faculty and the students admitted to First year UG Programmes 2021-22 are aware of the salient features and importance of NEP for the effective implementation. Further he suggested to get, if possible, feed-back from the stake holders regarding implementation of NEP syllabus to bring qualitative changes in education. He said Open Elective Courses have provided the students ample scope to gain knowledge in their interested subjects.

Prof. Sujatha Kumari, UG Department of History raised the point about the number of courses that a student has to study under NEP-2020 and she felt that the students are burdened with too many courses and limitation to understand all of them together in the stipulated period.

Dr. S. Prathiba, Department of Botany opined that the NEP-2020 has reduced the scope for learning domain knowledge and acquiring enhanced skill-based knowledge. She expressed her concern over completion of the syllabus within the stipulated time.

Dr. M. Kumaraswamy opined that the NEP-2020 UG syllabi has been designed with common credit pattern for all the UG programmes and suggested for convenient modifications if required according to the credit pattern in the following years. Dr. B. Prabhuswamy COE said that only in the Humanity Courses there are such discrepancies and Science and Commerce programmes have no such issues

Prof. B. V. Sambashivaiah said that with NEP-2020 scheme students are having the opportunities of gaining multidisciplinary knowledge and it is not a burden on them as students are capable of acquiring new skill-based knowledge options. The NEP-2020 UG syllabi have been appropriately designed according to the Course wise credit pattern and the opinion of teachers is as usual not positive to some extent whenever changes are made in the curriculum structures. He advised that teachers should not have prejudiced mind-set but open for changes. We have just conceived the new ideas; it takes some time to digest the concepts and it is not the right time to give opinions. Principal requested the faculty to get books for the library as per the new NEP syllabus

Dr. Vijaya Manjunathaguru proposed vote of thanks.
