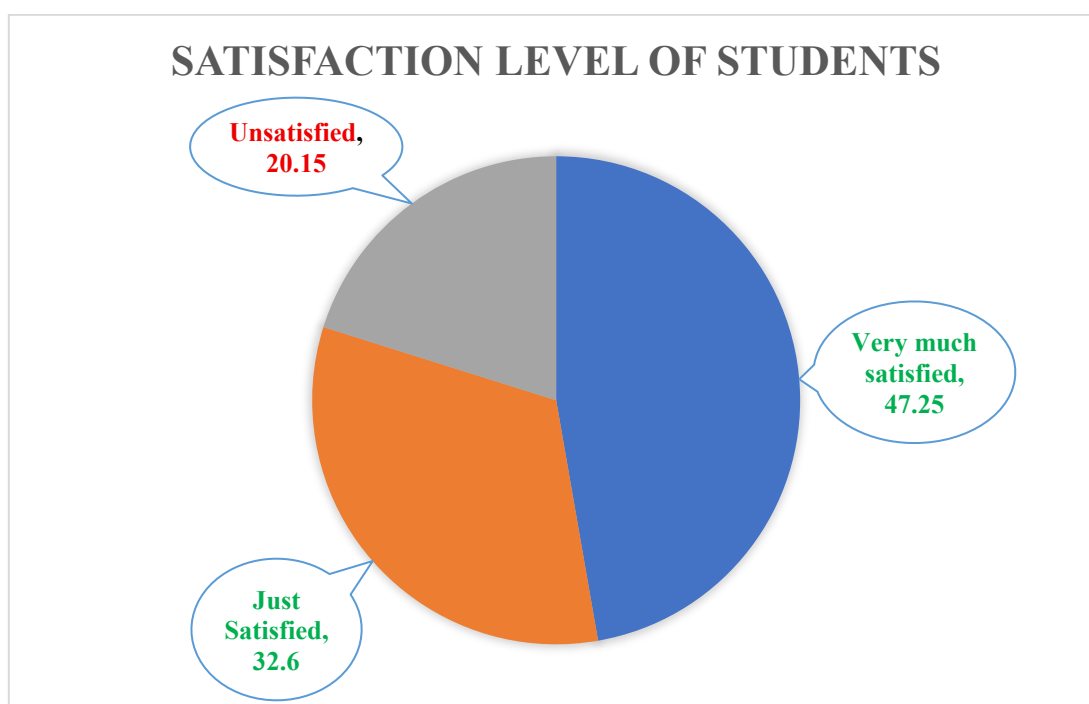

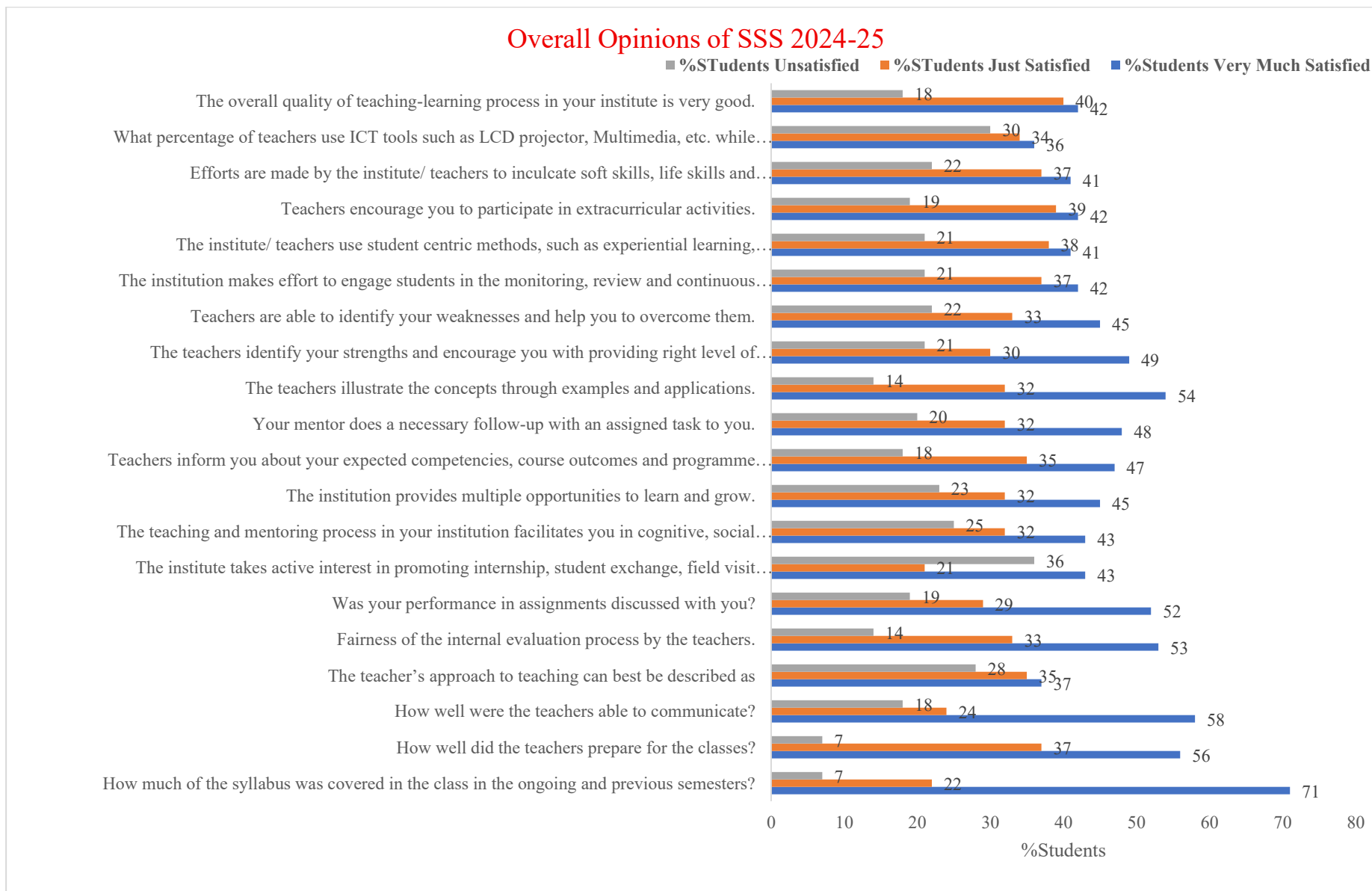

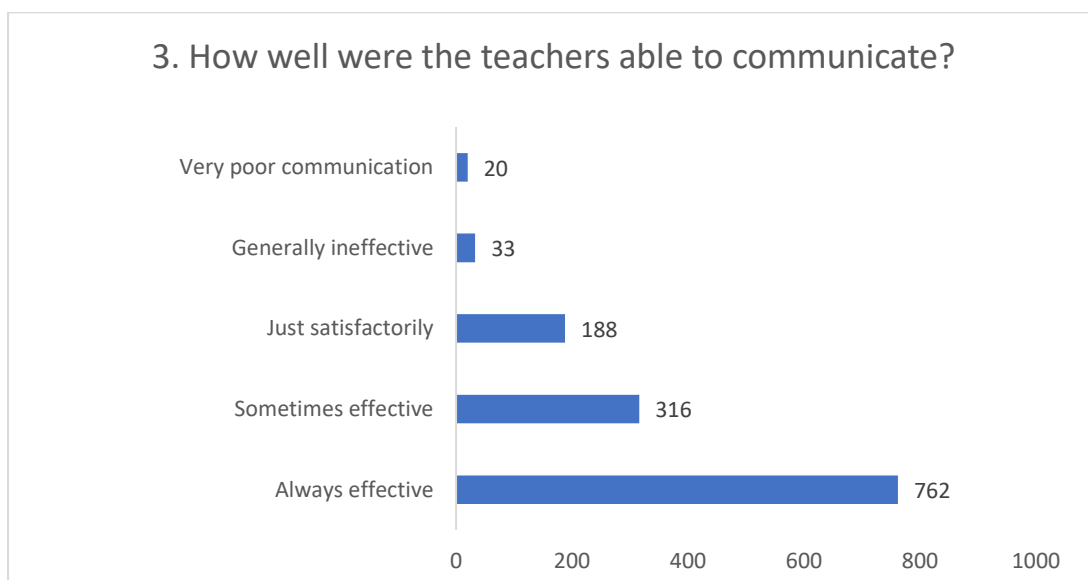
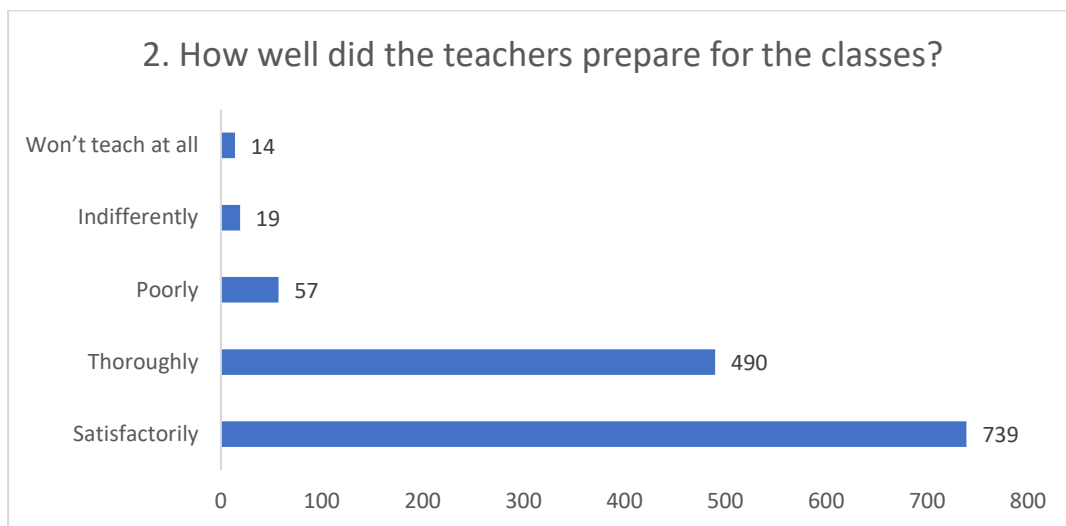
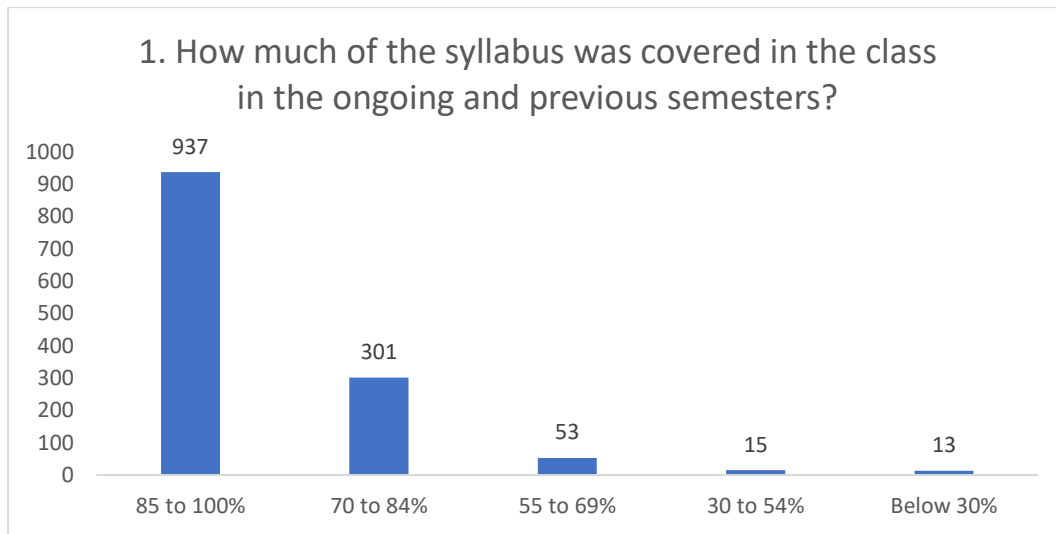
2. Overall opinion of students on quality of Teaching & Learning

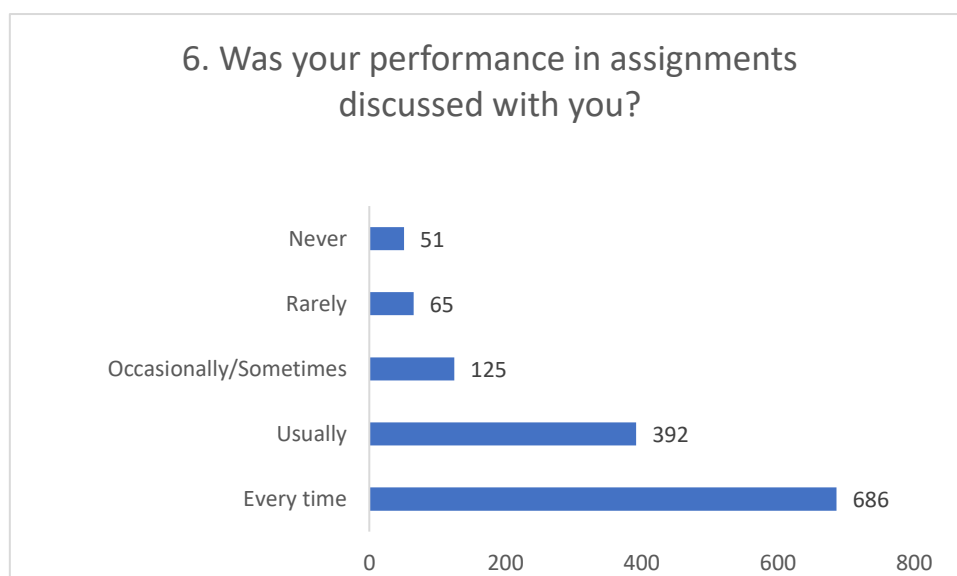
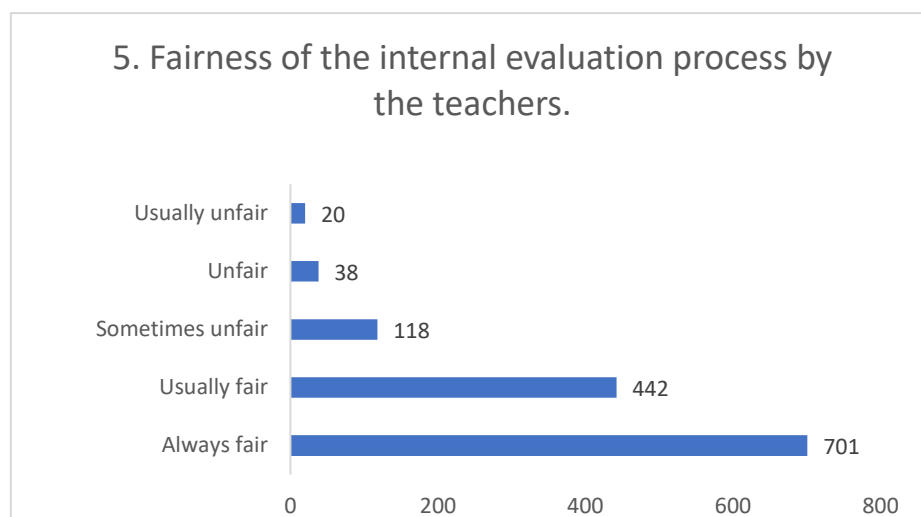
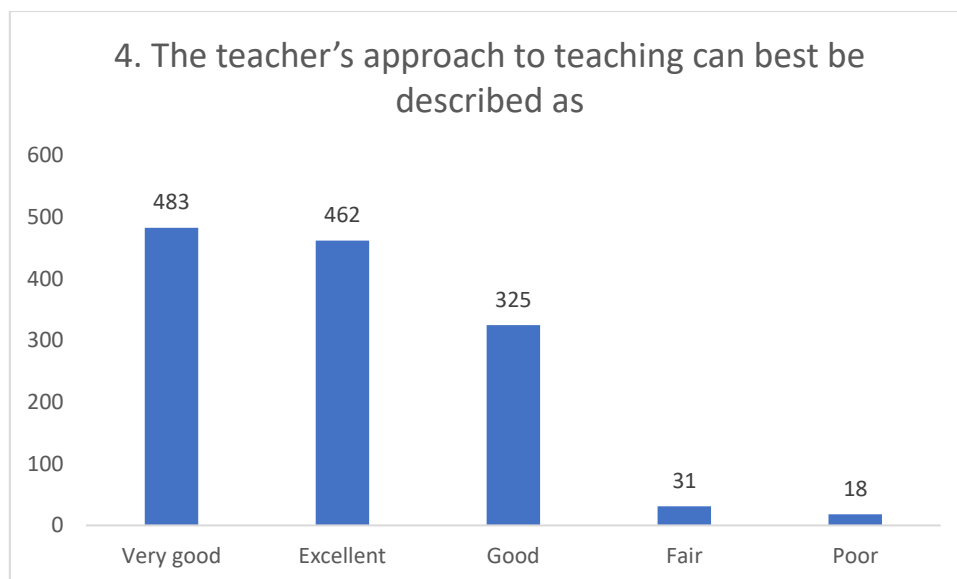


3. Overall picture of opinions by students on each question

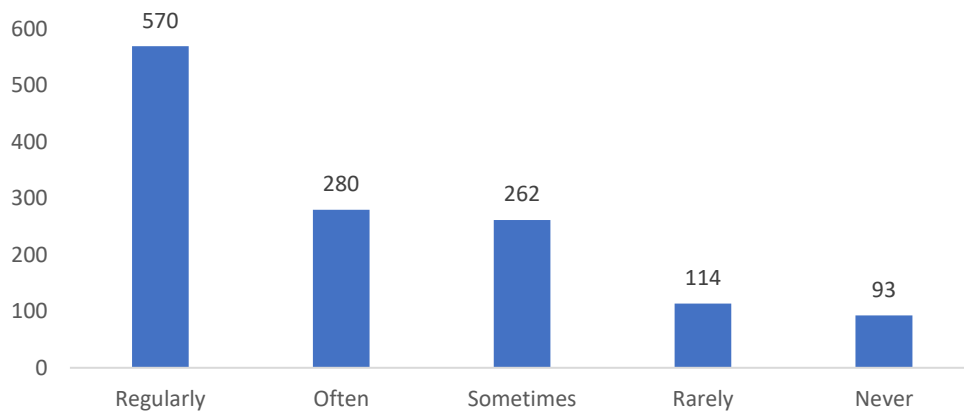


4. Question-wise responses by the students

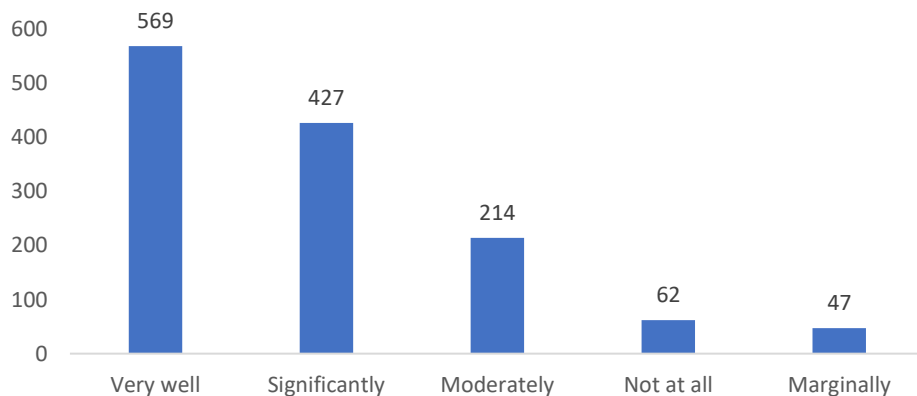




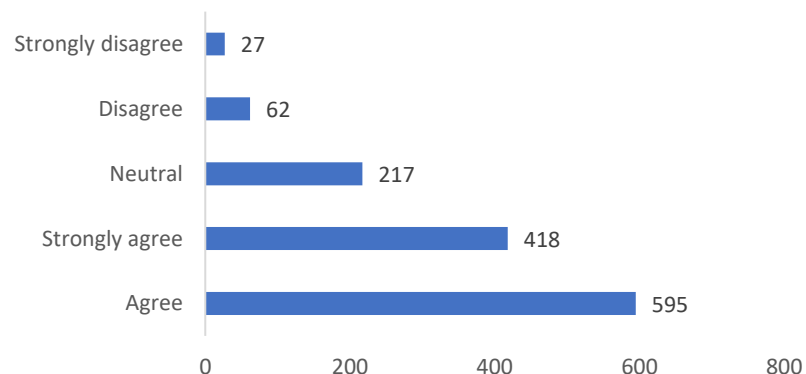

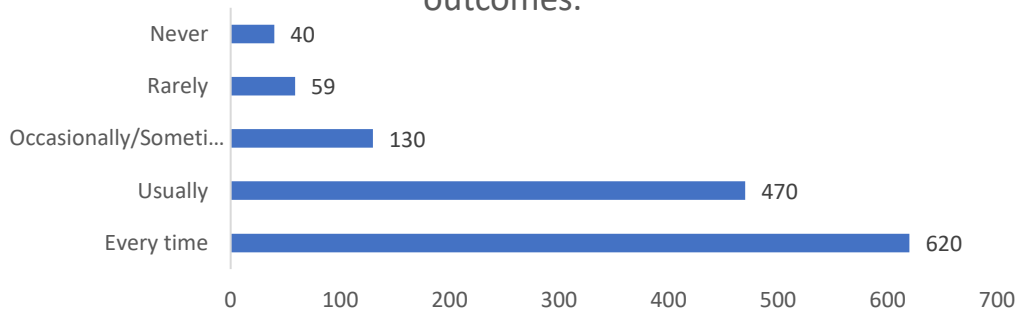
8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.



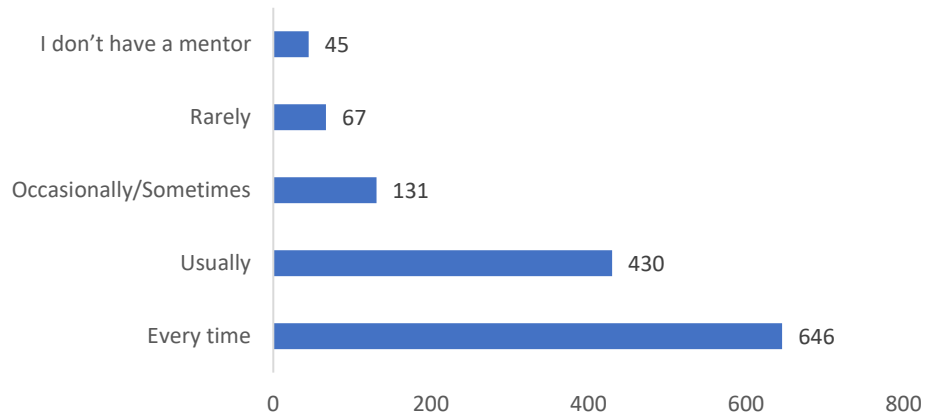
9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.



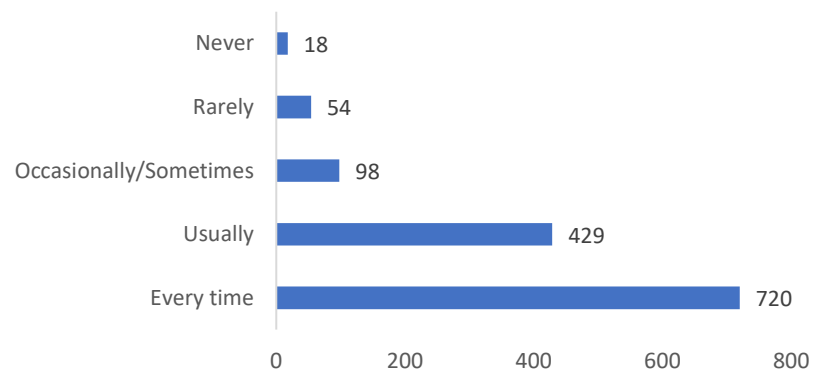
