Dear Principal,

This is with reference to the meeting held on 13th August, 2010 with the "Expert Committee on "Colleges with Potential for Excellence" (CPE) in the office of the Commission to finalize the item-wise budget and Action Plan of your college.

Pleased find **enclosed** the item-wise budget as approved by the Chairman, UGC in respect of your college for the years 2010-2011 and 2011-2012, based on the recommendation of the Expert Committee. **The amount already released to your college in this regard now may be utilized under finalized Non-recurring and Recurring items as per its allocation enclosed.**

As informed to you during the discussion, the CPE funds should **not** be used in respect of **unaided/self-financing departments/ courses** in your College. A certificate to the effect that the above instruction has been compiled which may kindly be sent immediately.

It was also observed during the discussion that still certain colleges are working as a Composite College. In such cases, the CPE funds should be used only for the degree programme and **not for the "+2" programme. A Certificate to this effect may kindly be sent. Further, action be taken to delink '+2' programmes from the college at the earliest.**

The faculty and Principals should not be transferred at least for a minimum period of three years, with effect from 2010-2011. This may kindly be brought to the notice of the authorities concerned and a **copy of the same may also be endorsed to UGC.**

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By the end of April every year, an Annual Report may be prepared by the College and submit to the UGC. The Annual Report should contain salient features of the steps taken by the college in implementing the CPE programme. The innovations introduced in the curriculum, teaching, evaluation, etc., may be highlighted. The report should not exceed two three pages of A-4 size paper. The report may be sent by E-mail and by courier so that it could be consolidated easily and sent for publication in the UGC Annual Report. This may kindly be confirmed.
