



Regarding the results of Odd Semester UG & PG programmes July 2021, Dr. C. G. Betsurmth suggested including previous year results into the Results of examinations.






AGENDA No – 36.4. Approval for UG and PG admissions for the academic year 2021-22

Member Secretary presented the details of admissions to different UG and PG Programmes for the year 2021-22 and requested the Governing Body for approval.

Discussion: The Chairperson and Dr. S. Srikantaswamy enquired about poor admissions to B.Voc. (SD) & M.Voc. (SD), M.Com. and M.A. programmes. Prof. B.V. Sambashivaiah clarified that majority of applicants to PG programmes have opted to take admissions in Government Colleges as the admission fee in Government Colleges is less compared to Private Colleges and the poor admissions to B.Voc. (SD) and M.Voc. (SD) programmes are due to non-availability of teaching faculty. Prof. B.V. Sambashivaiah added that now teachers are appointed and efforts are being made to improve admissions to the programmes. Prof. Morabada Mallikarjuna and Prof. K.S. Rangappa appreciated the admissions to Postgraduate Science programmes.

AGENDA No – 36.6 a. Approval for Regulation for four years UG Honours degree programme for the academic year 2021-22

The National Education Policy (NEP-2020) has recommended Multi-Disciplinary Undergraduate Programmes with multiple exit and entry options with Certificate/Diploma/Degrees at each of the exits. Undergraduate curriculum needs to be focused on creativity, innovation, critical thinking, higher order thinking capacities, problem solving abilities, team work, communication skills, more in-depth learning and mastery of curricula across fields. In view of this, the College has taken the initiative to implement the same from the academic year 2021-22.

Government of Karnataka has issued an order (No. ED 260 UNI 2019 (Part 1) Bengaluru dated 07.08.2021) for the implementation of Four years Multi-Disciplinary Undergraduate Honours Degree Programmes with multiple exit and entry options effective from the academic year 2021-22.

Out of five options for the Four years Multi-Disciplinary Undergraduate Honours Degree Programmes with corresponding suggestive Curricular and Credit structures and proposed CBCS schemes, the 'Dual Degree in Two Disciplines' is selected and the approval of JSS Mahavidyapeetha for the same is obtained.

The draft Regulations of Higher Education Council, Government of Karnataka with appropriate amendments/ changes has to be issued by University of Mysore to all the Affiliated Colleges including the Autonomous Colleges. Since University of Mysore has not framed NEP-2020 Regulations, being an Autonomous College, the draft Regulations has been prepared with an option open for accommodating necessary modifications satisfying the Regulations issued by the University of Mysore and UGC Autonomous College Regulations.

Academic Bank of Credits (ABC): The Academic Bank of Credits, a national-level facility will promote the flexibility of the curriculum framework and interdisciplinary/ multidisciplinary academic mobility of students across the Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) in the country with appropriate "credit transfer" mechanism. ABC will provide significant autonomy to the students by providing an extensive choice of courses for a program of study, flexibility in curriculum, novel and engaging course options across a number of higher education disciplines/ institutions.

The multiple entry and exit options for students is facilitated at the Undergraduate and

Master's levels. It would facilitate credit accumulation through the facility created by the ABC scheme in the "Academic Bank Account" opened for students across the country to transfer and consolidate the credits earned by them by undergoing courses in any of the eligible HEIs. HEIs offering programmes with the multiple entry and exit system need to register in the ABC to enable acceptance of multidisciplinary courses, credit transfer, and credit acceptance. The procedure for depositing credits earned, its shelf life, redemption of credits, would be as per UGC (Establishment and Operationalisation of ABC scheme in Higher Education) Regulations, 2021.

Member Secretary presented the draft Regulations of NEP-2020 prepared by the College effective from 2021-22 and registration for Academic Bank of Credits for approval (*Refer Annexure II*).

Discussion: Prof. K.S. Rangappa enquired about the two major combinations of Four years UG Honours Degree Programme for the academic year 2021-22 and poor admissions to Physics and Electronics combination. Prof. B.V. Sambashivaiah explained the details of two major combinations of four years UG Honours degree programme for the academic year 2021-22. Regarding poor admissions to Physics and Electronics combination, Prof. B.V. Sambashivaiah clarified that the scope for two major combinations with Computer Science in the present scenario might have affected the admissions to Physics and Electronics combination.

Decision: Approved

AGENDA No – 36.6 b. Approval for NEP 2020 Syllabi of UG Programmes

As an Autonomous College affiliated to University of Mysore, a meeting of HoDs of UG Departments was convened and discussed the framing of syllabi for four years UG Honours degree programme for the academic year 2021-22 following the syllabi of University of Mysore and the UGC Guidelines for Autonomous Colleges. The respective BOS of UG Departments discussed and resolved the adoption of the syllabi of University of Mysore with common evaluation pattern effective from 2021-22.

Member Secretary brought to the notice of the Governing Body about the syllabi of all the UG Departments and requested for the approval.

Discussion: Prof. K.S. Rangappa advised to take initiative for the preparation of Course Content for second year UG Honours degree programme and suggested to conduct workshop on NEP 2020. Prof. B.V. Sambashivaiah clarified that Government of Karnataka has not accorded permission for Colleges to prepare the Course Content for four years UG Honours degree programme, but to adopt that prepared by Higher Education Council, Government of Karnataka and accepted the suggestion to conduct workshop on NEP 2020.

Decision: Approved

AGENDA No – 36.6 c. Approval for Scheme and Syllabus of MCA Programme

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Master of Computer Applications is a 2 year Postgraduate Programme and is now offered by more than 73 institutions in the state and 1095 institutions all over India. MCA graduates form an important source of human resource for the software industry. Information Technology is growing rapidly. Increasing applications of computers in almost all areas of human endeavour has led to a vibrant industry with concurrent rapid change in technology. Thus the challenge in designing a curriculum is to identify the areas of core competence which is reasonably stable and provide sufficient number of electives and laboratories to accommodate changes. Thus the suggested programme has a strong laboratory and project orientation in which the use of new tools will be emphasized.

The College has introduced the 2-year MCA Programme from the academic year 2021-22 after obtaining the approvals from JSS Mahavidyapeetha, 34th Governing Body Meeting, University of Mysore and All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE). The BOS constituted for the MCA Programme has discussed the details of Scheme and Syllabus following the Guidelines of AICTE and finalized the Scheme and Syllabus effective from 2021-22.

Member Secretary presented the Scheme and Syllabus of MCA Programme for approval.

Decision: Approved
