TWO DAY PG STUDENT INDUCTION PROGRAMME 2025-26
An Initiative of IQAC

The Postgraduate Student Induction Programme – Deeksharambha 2025–26 was inaugurated at JSS College of Arts, Commerce and Science, Ooty Road, Mysuru, on 10 October 2025. The programme was inaugurated by Dr. S. R. Niranjana, Vice-Chairman, Karnataka State Higher Education Council, Bengaluru. In his inaugural address, Dr. Niranjana expressed his happiness, saying that visiting this institution felt like a “homecoming,” as University of Mysore and JSS Institutions have grown together over the years. Comparing Indian and Western education systems, he noted that while universities in Europe and the UK follow different models, India’s education began with the Gurukula system, emphasizing holistic learning. Ancient institutions like Nalanda and Takshashila gained global fame for their multi-disciplinary and quality education, which remains relevant today.

Dr. Niranjana stressed that interdisciplinary education is the need of the hour, and modern learning should be based on choice, not chance. He pointed out that today’s students often acquire knowledge that does not match the requirements of the real world. Therefore, self-assessment becomes crucial for understanding one’s strengths and weaknesses. He emphasized the importance of skill-based education, especially in the age of Artificial Intelligence, and urged students to integrate skill-oriented courses with their main specialization.

Quoting Jawaharlal Nehru, he remarked that “*only science, education, and technology can remove poverty from the country.*” He advised students to polish their personalities through proper dressing, communication, character building, and discipline while pursuing their postgraduate studies. “Knowledge is power,” he said, encouraging students to utilize all opportunities provided by the institution to sustain and succeed in their careers.

The Presidential Address was delivered by Prof. B. V. Sambashivaiah, Chief Executive. He extended a warm welcome to the newly admitted postgraduate students and spoke about the illustrious legacy of JSS Mahavidyapeetha, established under the guidance of His Holiness Jagadguru Dr. Sri Shivarathri Rajendra Mahaswamiji in 1954. The institution today manages over 350 institutions across India and abroad.

Prof. B. V. Sambashivaiah highlighted that JSS College, established in 1964, has a remarkable journey of 61 years and is among the select few colleges in India accredited with NAAC A+ Grade and recognized as a College with Potential for Excellence. The college offers a wide range of academic programs, from undergraduate to doctoral levels, including skill-based and value-added courses. It also houses UGC Skill Centre and Kaushal Karnataka Skill Training Centre, conducting multiple specialized courses.

Prof. B. V. Sambashivaiah explained that as per UGC guidelines (July 2019), the induction programme aims to introduce students to the academic, administrative, and cultural systems of the institution. It helps them adapt to a new environment, build relationships with teachers and peers, and develop values of empathy, discipline, and social responsibility.

Prof. B. V. Sambashivaiah encouraged students to maintain discipline, good conduct, and commitment to studies. He advised them to stay away from negative influences, to seek help whenever required, and to make the best use of the college’s opportunities for overall growth. He expressed confidence that the institution’s student-centered approach and quality education system would help students achieve their academic and career aspirations.

Following the inauguration, several sessions were conducted on the history and objectives of JSS Mahavidyapeetha, an introduction to various college cells, and information about short-term and online learning programs, including those offered through SWAYAM. The two-day Deeksharambha Programme will continue until 11 October 2025, featuring interactive sessions aimed at familiarizing students with the academic environment, institutional culture, and resources available for their personal and professional development.

The programme began with a welcome address by Dr. M. Prabhu, Principal of the college. The invocation was rendered by Ms. Dhanushree and Ms. Sahana, students of M.Sc. Chemistry. The vote of thanks was proposed by Dr. N. Rajendra Prasad, Coordinator, IQAC, and the session was moderated by Dr. Kavya H. V., Assistant Professor, PG Department of Chemistry.

The post-inaugural sessions began with **Prof. H. B. Devanna**, Department of Kannada, delivering an insightful talk on "*About Sri Suttur Math and JSS Mahavidyapeetha.*" He elaborated on the spiritual, educational, and social contributions of Sri Suttur Math and JSS Mahavidyapeetha in promoting holistic education and community development.

This was followed by **Dr. M. Prabhu**, Principal, who provided a "*Brief Introduction about the College,*" highlighting the institution's legacy, academic achievements, infrastructural facilities, and commitment to quality education.

Dr. M. Chethan Kumar, PG Department of Biochemistry, then presented the "*Rules and Regulations of the College*" session, acquainting students with academic discipline, attendance requirements, examination procedures, and code of conduct.

Dr. B. Prabhuswamy, Controller of Examinations, spoke on "*Assessment of Students,*" explaining the evaluation process, credit system, and the importance of continuous internal assessment.

After lunch, **Dr. Kumudini Achchi**, PG Department of Social Work, discussed "*Women Safety at Workplace and the Role of the Internal Complaints Committee (ICC).*" She sensitized students about gender equity, legal protections, and mechanisms for redressal of grievances.

A thought-provoking session on "*Mental Health and Well-being*" was conducted by **Dr. Shivananda Manohar J**, Psychiatrist, JSS Hospital, Mysuru. He stressed emotional resilience, stress management, and maintaining mental balance during academic life.

Mr. Srinivas, Librarian, then presented "*Library Information,*" introducing the students to digital databases, e-resources, and library facilities available for research and reference.

This was followed by **Mr. Karthik G**, Placement Officer, who oriented students on "*Placement Cell Activities*" and the various training programmes that enhance employability skills.

Mr. K. C. Sunil Kumar, Coordinator, CET Cell, gave an overview of "*JSS CACS Competitive Examination Training Cell,*" motivating students to utilize institutional support for civil service and competitive exam preparation.

The final session of the day, "*Physical Education,*" by **Mr. M. Karthik**, Physical Education Director, emphasized the importance of sports, yoga, and physical fitness for a balanced academic journey.

The second day began with **Dr. H. S. Kumara**, Coordinator, SWAYAM (University of Mysore), addressing students on "*SWAYAM/MOOCs for Students.*" He encouraged them to leverage online learning platforms for academic enrichment and interdisciplinary skill development.

Next, **Dr. Anil Kumar K. M.**, Professor & Head, Department of Computer Science, JSS Science and Technology University, delivered an engaging lecture on "*Good and Bad Influence of Social Media on Students.*" He discussed the constructive use of social media for learning, while cautioning against its potential distractions and misuse.

Dr. Sushmita B, PG Department of Social Work, spoke on "*Services in the College and Student Welfare Protection Measures.*" She has given about the Ant-ragging, student grievance and redressal cells, Internal Complaints and other committees which are functional to the support of students in creating safe atmosphere. She elaborated on student support systems, counseling services, and initiatives promoting inclusivity and safety on campus.

The talk on "*IQAC, OBE & Mentorship,*" was delivered by **Dr. N. Rajendraprasad**, Coordinator, IQAC. He emphasized the outcome-based education framework adopted by the college and the structured mentorship mechanism designed to support academic and personal growth. Then finally the programme was concluded by **Dr. N. Rajendraprasad**, Organising Secretary, who summarized the two-day activities and extended gratitude to all contributors and participants.

Post-lunch, students attended "*Orientation about Departmental Activities*" conducted by respective Heads of Departments and faculty members. These interactive departmental sessions provided detailed insights into curriculum design, research opportunities, and departmental facilities.

The two-day *Deeksharamba – PG Student Induction Programme* effectively introduced students to the institution's vision, academic framework, and welfare systems. The sessions emphasized ethics, mental health, academic integrity, and employability skills, ensuring a holistic transition into postgraduate education.
