Discussion:

- IQAC has taken curriculum feedback from all stakeholders, i.e., students, parents, alumni, employers and faculties

- The analysis report was prepared and shared by the vendor to the IQAC team
- It was observed that while in most of the areas the curriculum seemed to be okay, there were few areas where concern was expressed, flexibility of assessment, adequacy of essential questions and learning objective
- The IQAC has also resolved to initiate CBCS at UG level
- The IQAC suggested to incorporate the courses which focuses on employability so that the students will be able to get jobs in different sectors
